## FROM THE HORSE'S MOUTH

The \$250,000 JR & N Beckett Telegraph poses a few interesting scenarios on Saturday. Natuzzi could go one better this year after a decisive victory at Ellerslie last start. Barrier 16 however brings in a few risks. Trepidation will be seeking luck; the Falkirk gelding has been running on late. Expect similar tactics again. Soubrettes is currently favorite at \$4.80 for veteran jockey David Walsh. The 1200m handicap is famous for blistering sectionals. On a firm surface expect the time to be around the 1.07 mark. The track is currently Dead 4 and fine.

The \$240,000 AIB Group Insurance Levin Classic will showcases a clash of the best summer classic thoroughbreds. Stephen Marsh is no stranger to success with three year old fillies - he previously trained Lucia Valentina. Sardaaj is the outright favorite at \$2.10, while the fiercely talented Huka Eagle is a big threat at \$4.40.

Kawi looks a winning chance in the Tui-Backing a Winner Since 1889 Anniversary Handicap for Taranaki based trainer Allan Sharrock. The horse won over the course and distance in November, the previous experience puts him well into contention. The minimum of 53kg should aid the up and coming son of Savabeel.

## Meeting details:

- Otaki-Maori RC Monday meeting equivalent was run on a Sunday last season; 8 races this season, 7 last.
- Whangarei RC Tuesday meeting equivalent was run on the previous Friday in FY14.
- Racing Rotorua Thursday meeting equivalent was run on Monday in the previous season; 8 races this season, 7 last.
- Kumara RC Saturday meeting ran 11 races in FY15, 10 races in FY14.
- Egmont RC Sunday meeting equivalent was run at Waipukurau last season.

# Turnover summary notes:

- Total NZ thoroughbred turnover is up 2.7% year to date.
- 8 less meetings and 33 less races have been run than to the same date last season.
- Turnover per race is up 5.2%.
- Total starts made by thoroughbreds in NZ are down 244, 1.7% less.
- Average field size is 10.60 in FY15, up from 10.52 in FY14.
- The number of races with less than 8 starters is 13 less than the season prior (197 v 210).
- The decline in NZ thoroughbred totalisator turnover (down 3.4%) has been offset by an increase in FOB turnover (up 22.2%).
- Export turnover per race (\$NZ) is up 8.4% to 31 December.

Note: Turnovers are provided by the NZRB from various reports. On-course is totalisator turnover on the meeting and on intertrack meetings, plus FOB racing turnover on the meeting only (FOB intertrack is not provided from these reports at present). Total NZRB racing turnover is NZ thoroughbred, harness, greyhound plus all imported thoroughbred, harness and greyhound turnover; combined with sports this provides the total NZRB turnover. NZ thoroughbred export turnovers are stated in \$NZ, generally up to a week or two behind other turnover numbers.
