The Canterbury Jockey Club Winter carnival came to a close on Saturday. The carnival showcased the best winter gallopers and proved to be a popular spectacle. The support from participants around New Zealand was prominent. The track was well sustained with multiple meetings in a short timeframe.

Leda Beck's Gargamel was a popular winner of the Grand National Hurdle, despite not being admired on the tote. The steeplechase also proved to be a thrilling contest with Aaron Bidlake's Eric the Viking claiming the \$75,000 prestige jumping race. Congratulations to connections of winners throughout the carnival.

All eyes will be on the Foxbridge Plate this Saturday. The Plate obtained an International rating of 113.5 last season. Common sense indicates the race is outperforming its current Group Three status. The Pattern Review Committee will consider all options this Friday. Acceptances include Group one winners Veyron, Viadana, Xanadu and Pure Champion.

Racing Taupo host their first meeting of the season next week. Previous years, this meeting is proven to host future stars such as Atlante, El Roca and Puccini.

A special mention for first time dad Ocean Park, his first foal was born last week at Trelawney Stud.

#### **RACING STARS BACK INAUGURAL DAFFODIL RACE DAY**

Some of the superstars of New Zealand Racing are uniting to support Kiwis affected by cancer. The Hawkes Bay Racing Club has declared the first Group One Race of the season – traditionally known as Makfi Stakes Day – Daffodil Race Day.

#### **OTAKI-MAORI RC ON SATURDAY 16 AUGUST - TO BE HELD AT AWAPUNI**

Following an inspection of the Otaki track this morning a decision has been made to transfer the Saturday, 16 August Otaki-Maori raceday to Awapuni. Following a very wet winter and 84ml of rain over the weekend, parts of the Otaki track had become waterlogged and an early decision has been made to change the venue to make sure the day can proceed. The programme will remain the same for the day at Awapuni. It will also remain an Otaki-Maori Licence.

#### WOODVILLE-PAHIATUA RACING CLUB - THURSDAY 21 AUGUST - FINAL RACE CONFIRMED

The following race has been added to the programme for the Woodville-Pahiatua Racing Club's race meeting on Thursday 21 August 2014.

#### Benchmark Rating 65 – 2100m

Of \$7,000. \$4,375, \$1,400, \$700, \$350, \$175.

All other races on the programme remain unaltered.

The flexibility to programme the extra race is designed to provide an opportunity for horses which might otherwise not be able to start.

#### **TAUPO RC WEDNESDAY 20 AUGUST - TRIAL HEATS**

NZTR, following consultation with the Club, the Northern Regional Programming Committee and the Trainers Association, confirms that there will be a trial opportunity for 'Stakes Performers Only' in the morning prior to the Taupo RC races taking place.

This decision has been made following numerous requests for exhibition gallops throughout the day at the Taupo RC meeting of which all could not be catered for.

The trial heat will be an OPN 1100m heat with the Special Condition of 'Stakes Performers only'.

Nominations will close with the National Racing Bureau at 12 Noon Friday 15 August.

#### SOUTH CANTERBURY RC - FRIDAY 22 AUGUST - EXTRA RACE PROGRAMMED

NZTR in conjunction with the Southern Regional Programming Committee have programmed a Benchmark Rating 75 1600m race at the South Canterbury meeting, Friday 22 August. This has been added to provide those horses and others with an opportunity following the deletion of the R75 1600m race at the Oamaru JC, 14 August.

Benchmark Rating 75 1600m \$8,000 – **added** to South Canterbury Friday 22 August.

All other races remain unaltered. Nominations close with the NRB at 12 Noon, Tuesday 19 August.

## SOUTH CANTERBURY RC - MONDAY 22 SEPTEMBER - STAKE INCREASE

The South Canterbury RC have increased the stake of the Benchmark Rating 75 Hcp 1600m race at their Monday 22 September meeting.

Benchmark Rating 75 Hcp 1600m - increased from \$8,000 to \$10,000.

#### **Meeting details**

- Hawke's Bay RI Thursday meeting was 9 races this season, 7 last season.
- Matamata RC Friday equivalent meeting was run on the following Monday in FY14; 6 races in FY15, 7 races in FY14.
- Racing Te Aroha Sunday equivalent meeting was on a Friday last season.

#### Turnover summary notes:

- Total NZ thoroughbred turnover is down 9.3% year to date.
- 6 less races have been run than to the same date last season.
- As a result, turnover per race is only down 1.9%.
- Total starts made by thoroughbreds in NZ are down 79, 10.1% less.
- Average field size is 9.50 in FY15, down from 9.78 in FY14.
- The number of races with less than 8 starters is 3 lower than the season prior.
- The decline in NZ thoroughbred totalisator turnover (down 16.8%) is partly offset by an increase in FOB turnover (up 20.1%).
- \$NZ export turnover figures for the new season are not yet available.
