The Group One \$200,000 Wellington Rydges Captain Cook Stakes has drawn a select field. I Do, Puccini and Pure Champion are stars of the spring and look to bring their form into the summer. Puccini has won over the course and distance recently.

The abandonment of the Levin R.C meeting at Otaki last Friday will see the Listed \$50,000 Chainey's Panasonic Levin Stakes and a newly added \$50,000 Ekraar & Echoes of Heaven@Linwood Park Three Year Old 1400 run at Trentham. And a \$50,000 Three Year Old 1600 has been added to the 20th Manawatu R.C. meeting at Awapuni Racecourse.

December marks the start of Summer racing, A Premier meeting will feature once a week until 30 January. The Wellington and Waipukurau meetings will be Christmas at the Races events this weekend and Auckland's meeting will see last week's impressive winner Tavy. NORM HOLLAND RECOGNISES THE GENERAL TRUST FUND

Norman (Norm) Holland, OBE, who died on Sunday at the age of 90, has generously bequeathed \$32,024 to the NZTR General Trust Fund.

NZTR Chairman, Matthew Goodson, and the three trustees of the General Trust Fund - John Rattray, Keith Neylon and Colin Jenkins - have expressed their appreciation for Norm Holland's bequest.

Matthew Goodson added: "These funds were gathered by Norm during his lifetime for the express purpose of assisting jockeys and other licensees."

"The Fund provides financial assistance to current or former licensees who are injured or, for whatever reason, find themselves in difficulty. During the last 12 months it has helped many people in the racing industry including, for example, Thomas Russell, Grant Laursen and Ashley Frye, to name only three."

"This donation is just one of many ways through which Norm has made a huge contribution to racing in New Zealand over his long life."

Norm Holland's funeral will be at Ellerslie at 9am, before racing, this Saturday, 6 December.

Meeting details:

- Racing Te Aroha Wednesday meeting ran 11 races; last season the equivalent meeting was on the following Monday and ran 8 races.
- Waipa RC Thursday meeting ran 9 races in FY15, 8 in FY14.
- Levin RC Friday meeting was abandoned due to unsafe track conditions after 3 races this season; 9 were run last season.
- Winton JC Friday twilight meeting ran 6 races in FY15; no direct equivalent in FY14.
- Auckland RC Saturday meeting ran 9 races this season, 10 last season.
- Otago RC at Cromwell Sunday meeting ran 11 races in FY15, 9 in FY14.

Turnover summary notes:

- Total NZ thoroughbred turnover is up 2.6% year to date.
- 7 less meetings and 40 less races have been run than to the same date last season.
- Turnover per race is up 7.0%.
- Total starts made by thoroughbreds in NZ are down 268, 2.6% less.
- Average field size is 10.79 in FY15, up from 10.63 in FY14.
- The number of races with less than 8 starters is 31 less than the season prior (112 v 143).
- The decline in NZ thoroughbred totalisator turnover (down 3.3%) has been offset by an increase in FOB turnover (up 22.7%).
- Export turnover per race (\$NZ) is up 6.6% to 23 November.

Note: Turnovers are provided by the NZRB from various reports. On-course is totalisator turnover on the meeting and on intertrack meetings, plus FOB racing turnover on the meeting only (FOB intertrack is not provided from these reports at present). Total NZRB racing turnover is NZ thoroughbred, harness, greyhound plus all imported thoroughbred, harness and greyhound turnover; combined with sports this provides the total NZRB turnover. NZ thoroughbred export turnovers are stated in \$NZ, generally up to a week or two behind other turnover numbers.
