Important Notice – Changes to Northern Region Programmes

The recent decision to defer the resumption of racing at Avondale has resulted in some changes to the programmes contained in the latest Programme Booklets and the April issue of the *Thoroughbred Racing Monthly*. These changes affect the following race meeting licenses:

Full details of the amendments can be obtained from the Racing Calendar on the NZTR website or by contacting the National Racing Bureau. Printing and publishing deadlines unfortunately precluded the inclusion of these changes in the April issue of the *Thoroughbred Racing Monthly*.

Hawera 2100m Start Distances - 12 March

A review by New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing and the Racing Integrity Unit has determined that the starting gates at the Egmont Racing Club meeting conducted at Hawera on Monday 12 March were incorrectly positioned for the two 2100m distance races.

The Egmont Racing Club has confirmed that their staff made an error in positioning the gates for the two 2100m races at the 2000m mark after the Club had measured the track circumference and made an adjustment to allow for the rail being moved out 5m from 600m point.

NZTR has corrected the official results to show that both Race 1 the Lowe Schollum and Jones/NZI Maiden and Race 5 the Platinum Homes (NZ) 2100m were run over 2000m, not 2100m.
