Santa's Pick Cap – NZ Racing Board and NZTR Appreciation

The On-Course Marketing and Events team at the NZ Racing Board, and participating Thoroughbred Racing Clubs, have expressed their appreciation to all the owners who allowed their Jockeys to wear the Santa's Pick cap at Christmas at the Races events this season. Although not mandatory, and not worn in Black Type races, many owners allowed the cap to replace their usual colours when nominated.

Although initially designed to help the high number of 'first time' race-goers at Christmas at the Races events pick out a horse and experience the thrill of a winning bet – the success also spread off-course.

While popular on-course the promotion also gained a loyal following among TAB Phonebet, Internet and retail customers and has visibly boosted turnover. Last year around \$300k worth of turnover was generated on-course by the promotion in conjunction with the \$2 each way Christmas Cracker bet slip.

The promotion has again demonstrated how it benefits Clubs, industry and customers alike – and its ability to drive turnover and therefore stakes – and the role that owners play in making it all possible is greatly appreciated.
