Earlier Withdrawal Times from 14 January

The withdrawal time for ALL race meetings has been brought forward and will now close at 10 am. This change will be effective from **Saturday 14 January**, **2012** when withdrawals are taken for the **Wednesday 18 January Whangarei RC** meeting and will be applicable to all thoroughbred meetings from this date.

The withdrawal times have been brought forward one hour from 11 am after consultation by NZTR with the three Regional Programming Committees and the NZ Trainers Association to assist with the printing and distribution schedules for the NZRB Turf Digest/Best Bets publications.

- (4) Domestic thoroughbreds total turnover for this week was down 13.4% (-\$1.04m) with ten less races (-16.1%). Horse starts were down 21.7% last week, with average field sizes of 12.0 for the week resulting in field sizes 0.8 starters a race greater than in the same week last year. The Group 3 Manawatu Cup at Awapuni was the largest betting race for the week with turnover (tote and fob) of \$396k up 60% on last year (\$248k) with 18 starters vs 10 last year, while the other Group 3 at the meeting the Challenge Stakes (\$303k) was up (+\$102k or 51%) on last year.
