Meeting Details

- Racing Tauranga Monday meeting equivalent was a week later in FY13. 8 races in FY14, 9 in FY13.
- Racing Te Aroha Wednesday meeting had no direct equivalent in FY13. 11 races run this season.
- Woodville-Pahiatua RC Thursday meeting equivalent ran a week earlier in FY13. 8 races this season, 9 last season.
- South Canterbury RC Friday meeting equivalent ran a week earlier in FY13.
- Waikato RC Saturday meeting equivalent ran 10 races this season, 9 races last season.

Turnover Summary Notes

- Total NZ thoroughbred turnover is down 1.2% year to date.
- With 92 less races than run over the same period last season, turnover per race has actually increased, up 2.6%.
- Total starts made by thoroughbreds in NZ are down 867, 3.4% less.
- Average field size is up from 10.39 in FY13 to 10.35 in FY14, 0.04 starters per race (0.4%) more.
- The number of races with less than 8 starters is now 32 higher than a season ago.
- The decline in NZ thoroughbred totalisator turnover (down 4.5%) has been partly offset by an increase in FOB turnover (up 11.3%).
- \$NZ export turnover per race to 30 April is down (12.4%). The variance in the \$NZ/\$A exchange rate is responsible for a large proportion of this decline. The remainder, as well as the absence of any growth, appears to have resulted from the loss of coverage on Sky 1 in Australia for midweek races run after 2 pm.
