Racing turnover was down 5.0% (-\$1.22m) for the week, Racing Tote was down just 9.6% (-\$2.07m) with Domestic tote down 19.0% (-\$2.29m).

Domestic thoroughbreds turnover was down 19.3% (-\$1.06m) with the same number of meetings and four less races (-7.4%) with horse starts also down 16.7%.

FOB Racing, with 193 Final Field Place options offered (\$646k) was up 28.7% (+\$850k) last week (up 42% or \$747k domestically), with 198 more options overall (+49%) available than in the same week last year.

Note: NZRB supplied On-course Turnover total represents On-course turnover placed on NZ thoroughbred meetings from all on-course venues. 'Total' NZ Thoroughbred turnover figure includes Off-course (including Pick 6), On-course (NZRB figure as commented above) and all Fixed Odds Turnover. All Turnover figures are supplied by the NZRB.
