Avondale Return to Racing to be Rescheduled

The Avondale Jockey Club meeting scheduled for Wednesday 25 April is now planned to be held at Counties. NZTR is in discussion with the New Zealand Racing Board Dates Committee and both the Avondale JC and Counties RC, and expect to be able to confirm the change in the licence and any consequential programming changes by Thursday this week.

As a result of the proposal for the Avondale JC Anzac day licence being run at Counties, the Counties Racing Club licence on Monday 16 April has been transferred to Waipa. The Waipa programme for Monday 16 April will remain as was advertised for the Counties meeting that day in the *Thoroughbred Racing Monthly* except for the following distance changes:

NZTR is working with the Northern Regional Programming Committee and the New Zealand Racing Board to confirm venue changes for the Avondale Jockey Club meetings that were programmed for Wednesday 2 May and Wednesday 23 May, 2012.

At this time subject to NZRB confirmation and further discussion with the respective Clubs it is planned for the Wednesday 2 May meeting to now be conducted by the Whangarei Racing Club at Ruakaka and the Wednesday 23 May licence by the Waipa Racing Club. Programmes and any consequential distance changes will be advised shortly when the licence changes are confirmed.

The decision to postpone a return to racing at Avondale was made last Thursday following jump-outs on the track.

Chief Stipendiary Steward Cameron George reported that the Avondale track had raced inconsistently and appeared to be quite deep. The track was also cutting out in places. "It was evident to all parties involved that the track will benefit by having some more time to consolidate given the extent of the drainage and sand slitting work that had been carried out earlier this year. "

NZTR will continue to work with the Club with a view to programming trials and racing resuming at Avondale once it has been established that the track is ready.

Overall turnover was down 0.5% (- \$147k) last week on the same week last year, + 4.0% season to date.

Racing turnover was up 2.2% (+ \$0.56m) for the week, Racing Tote was down 4.1% (- \$0.9m) with Domestic tote down 11.7% (- \$1.5m). Domestic thoroughbreds turnover was down 11.3% (- \$775k) with broadly the same number of horse starts.

Import tote turnover was up 6.3% on the same week last year (+ \$588k) with 13.4% more races taken.

FOB Racing, with 204 Final Field Place options offered (\$827k) was up 52.2% (+ \$1.46m) last week (up 68% or \$1.29m domestically), with + 59% more options available than in the same week last year.

Note: NZRB supplied On-course Turnover total represents On-course turnover placed on NZ thoroughbred meetings from all on-course venues.
