# **Pattern Review Committee Calls For Submissions**

The New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing (NZTR)-appointed Pattern Review Committee is to carry out a review of the current pattern and performance of black type racing in New Zealand, with a particular emphasis on Group 1 and Group 2 races, at the request of the New Zealand Pattern Committee. The Pattern Review Committee comprises Mark Freeman, who will chair the review, Gary Chittick, John Wheeler (MNZM) and Neville McAlister.

The Pattern Review Committee, which met on 10 May 2013, is calling for submissions from race clubs, industry stakeholders and any other interested parties on any of the issues identified in its terms of reference including, in particular, on any proposed changes that will enhance the current pattern and performance of black type racing in New Zealand.

The closing date for submissions is Wednesday 12 June 2013.

### Consultation on Proposed Amendments to the Rules of Racing

A number of proposed amendments to the Rules of Racing have been distributed to race clubs, sector organisations and the other codes, and posted on the website for industry consultation.

A proposed prohibition on jockey's betting, a requirement for horses to be named before trialling and a deregistration process for thoroughbreds are among some of the proposed changes for consultation.

The period of consultation closes on 7 June 2013, however NZTR will accept submissions until close of business on 11 June 2013. Feedback on these proposed amendments will be reviewed by NZTR's Integrity Committee at its meeting on 12 June 2013.

# 2013 Show Gate Awards Ladies Who Love Racing

Mrs Harley has had a long term involvement with racing through owning and breeding racehorses from her Nelson property of Ashbury Stud. The Ashbury name is retained in the name of her horses of which over 35 have been seen on the South Island race tracks since 1995 from Ashbury Andrew to Ashbury Yelrah.

#### **Mrs Joan Meates**

Nominated by Kumara Jockey Club

Mrs Meates is an 82-year-old life member of the Kumara Jockey Club who works tirelessly maintaining and preparing the Kumara Racecourse facilities for the club's celebrated race meeting. She has served on the committee for over 20 years.

#### **Mrs Marion Stevenson**

Nominated by the Otago Racing Club

Mrs Stevenson has been a backbone member of the Otago Racing Club and is a former President and Life Member. She also served on the NZTR Board as the South Island representative. Marion harbours a deep love for jumps racing and bred Nearco Bay, which was leased to the Queen Mother and famously became Her Majesty's 400th race winner.
