Notice of Proposed Amendments – Rules of Racing

The Integrity Committee of New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing (NZTR) has approved for further industry consultation the following proposed amendments to the Rules of Racing.

These proposed amendments seek to amend Rules of Racing regarding:

- 1. Pregnant mares (Rule 652)
- 2. Remounting during a race, entering a race track during the running of a race and pulling up (Rules 603, 636 & 640)
- 3. Renaming the 'Graded Stakes Committee' the 'New Zealand Pattern Committee' (Rules 104 & 506)
- 4. Decisions of the Judicial Committee (Rule 920 (3) (c))
- 5. Drug & alcohol testing of all those involved in safety sensitive activities in the preparation and presentation of horses (Rules 104, 208, 322, 344 (new), 656-7, 803, 812 (new) & 902)

Additional South Island Races for Oamaru and South Canterbury

NZTR has approved an additional flat race being added to the advertised programmes at both the Oamaru Jockey Club meeting on Thursday 21 June and the South Canterbury Racing Club meeting on Friday 13 July 2012.

At the Oamaru JC meeting on 21 June, the additional race added to the programme is an \$8,000 Rating 75 Benchmark 2200m Handicap. At the South Canterbury meeting on 13 July a \$7,000 Rating 65 Benchmark 2100m Handicap has now been programmed.

The changes have been made to support Club and South Island Regional Programming opportunities through this period.

There are four jumping races scheduled to be run at both the Oamaru and South Canterbury meetings. In accordance with NZTR policy if there are not sufficient entries for any of the jumping races at either of these meetings, that race may be deleted at nomination time. Along with the decision to programme the two additional flat races, NZTR will also consider dividing a Maiden or one of the other races on the programme if there are sufficient nominations should the number of jumping races on the day be reduced.

EstarOnline Winter Cup

EstarOnline are the new sponsors of the Canterbury Jockey Club Winter Cup, the 115th running of which is set to take place on Saturday 4 August.

The \$100,000, Group 3, EstarOnline Winter Cup will herald in the new racing season and underpin also its first Premier raceday on the first day of the New Zealand Grand National Racing Carnival.

Canterbury Jockey Club Chairman Jeff McCall welcomed EstarOnline and acknowledged their leadership in ecommerce, something reiterated by their Chief Executive, Stuart Clark.

Overall turnover was up 6.3% (+\$1.87m) last week on the same week last year, +4.7% season to date.

Racing turnover was up 4.6% (+\$1.17m) for the week, with Domestic racing up 3.6% (+\$497k).

Domestic thoroughbreds turnover was up 11.6% (+\$713k) (tote + fob) with two additional meetings and ten more races (+18.2%), with horse starts up 31.4%.

Note: NZRB supplied On-course Turnover total represents On-course turnover placed on NZ thoroughbred meetings from all on-course venues.
