Goodson re-appointed Chairman of NZTR

The Board of New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing (NZTR) announced today the re-appointment of Mr Matthew Goodson as its Chairman. Mr Joe Walls was appointed Deputy Chairman.

The election took place after the Annual General Meeting held in Wellington on Tuesday 6 December 2011. The Chairman and Deputy Chairman are appointed annually by the Board from among its directors.

The other three directors are Con Anastasiou, Greg McCarthy and John Stace.

The Members' Council is currently seeking applications for the vacant sixth seat on the Board.

On his re-appointment Mr Goodson stated: "I appreciate the confidence and support of the Board."

"Together with my fellow Directors, I look forward to continuing our plans to grow thoroughbred racing, as set out in our proposed Business Plan, unveiled at the AGM, before presenting it at regional meetings around the country over the next two weeks. The Board also looks forward to working collaboratively over the next 12 months with all our stakeholders, the Racing Board, Harness Racing and the Greyhound Racing Association."

Increase Minimum Weight Open Handicaps

The NZTR Board has increased the minimum declared weight from 53kg to 54kg for all Open Handicap races run at Feature, Tier Two Feature and Industry meetings.

The change to the minimum declared weight in Feature Open races and all lower key Open type races is to be implemented from Monday 11 December, 2011.

As a result of the amendment to NZTR Standard Racing Regulation 8.1 a 54kg Open Handicap minimum weight will now apply to the Canterbury Jockey Club's \$12,000 Open 1400m Handicap on Friday, 16 December and the two \$20,000 Open Handicap races being run at 1600m and 2100m at the Waikato Racing Club's Saturday 17 December Feature meeting.

The change is being implemented immediately to support the busy upcoming Christmas/New Year racing period. In Open races with a 54kg minimum handicap the minimum topweight at release of weights remains at 59kg with a 58kg minimum topweight required still at withdrawal time.

Open Handicap races conducted at Premier meetings will continue to have a 53kg minimum. The minimum weight for Listed and Group Three Handicaps will also remain at 53kg.

Transfer Horses to Another Race After Weights Have Been Released

The NZTR Board has also supported a change to section 6.2 of the NZTR Standard Racing Regulations that will allow a horse to now be transferred to another race, prior to the advertised withdrawal time, where that horse may otherwise not have had an opportunity to start when a race is cancelled, or the horse would have been eliminated from a race, or placed on the ballot.

The change to the Regulations will become effective from Monday 11 December. Under current regulations a horse can only be transferred into another race that is not a Group or Listed race, in circumstances where that race is a set weight race, or where weights have not been released. In part this has been due to the perception that once weights have been declared, a horse being transferred may unduly influence the handicap.

Under the existing ratings based handicapping system, an R72 horse nominated for a R75 1600m Handicap could not be transferred into (say) the R75 2000m Handicap if at withdrawal time the Rating 1600m race was going to be deleted due to a lack of entries.

As a result of this change to the regulations, that horse will now be able to be transferred into any other race in which it is eligible to start. The weight to be carried will be determined by the handicapper and will reflect the position of that horse in the ratings relative to the weights that have already been declared for that race.

For the purpose of field selection, a horse transferred into another race in accordance with this regulation will be deemed to be late nominated for that race.

Ashburton Trials Meeting now to be held on Tuesday 13 December

The Ashburton trials were cancelled on Tuesday due to unsafe track conditions. The Banks Peninsula RC has also advised that it is not in a position to hold its scheduled trials on Tuesday 20 December.

Accordingly a separate trials meeting has now been rescheduled for Tuesday 13 December to be held at Ashburton. Nominations close with the National Racing Bureau at 12 noon on Monday 12 December.

Auckland RC & South Canterbury RC 28 December – Amended Withdrawals Deadlines

For the Auckland RC and South Canterbury RC 28 December meetings withdrawals will now close at 2 pm on Friday 23 December (following closing of nominations at 12 noon). This is necessary to ensure the race fields are included in appropriate media publications.

Waikouaiti RC – Stake Increases and Distance Changes for 1 January 2012 Meeting

The Waikouaiti RC has announced the following stake increases for its meeting on 1 January 2012.

Waikouaiti Cup, Open Handicap, 2000m, and the Open handicap 1250m are now to be run for a stake of \$13,120 (previously \$12,000), \$7,500, \$2,400, \$1,200, \$600, \$300, horses placed 6th-12th \$160.

Following an inspection of the Waikouaiti course, the 1150m distance has been changed to 1125m, and the 2000m distance has been changed to 1975m. This is necessary to safely accommodate the new starting gates which will be in use at this meeting.
