NZRB BECOMES A FOUNDING MEMBER OF ASIAN-AFRICAN TOTE ASSOCIATION

The Asian-African Tote Association (AATA) was officially formed and held its first Executive Committee meeting last month. It aims to strengthen ties between leading wagering operators. The nine founding members of the AATA are:

The Japan Racing Association and the Korean Racing Authority have joined as observer organisations.

At its first meeting, The Hong Kong Jockey Club's Executive Director of Customer and Marketing, Richard Cheung, was elected AATA's inaugural President and Brendan Parnell, Chief Operating Officer of Tabcorp's Media and International Business was elected Vice President.

Members of AATA will work together to advance members' common interests on issues such as:

- Technology advancements in totalisator and wagering operations;
- Commingling standards and the harmonisation of betting rules;
- The sustainable funding of the racing industry;
- Providing responsible wagering services;
- Combating illegal and unauthorised wagering operators; and
- Customer and marketing initiatives.

WAIMATE RC RACE MEETING LICENCES - SUNDAY 8 JUNE & MONDAY 7 JULY 2014

There are changes to the previously published Waimate RC programmes for its 7 July race meeting. This has been necessary following extensive damage to the Waimate venue following a storm.

The race meeting licence programmed for Monday 7 July has been relinquished and has not been replaced.

Meeting details

Otaki-Maori RC's Monday meeting equivalent was run by Waverley RC in FY13 due to the drainage work undertaken on the Course Proper at Otaki.

Avondale JC Wednesday meeting was abandoned due to storm damage to its horse stall facilities. The equivalent meeting was run by Whangarei RC last season, with 10 races.

Wanganui JC Thursday meeting held 7 races in FY14, 9 races in FY13.

South Canterbury RC Friday meeting held 7 races this season, 8 races last season.

Manawatu RC Saturday meeting ran 9 races in FY14, 8 races in FY13.

Whangarei RC Saturday meeting equivalent was run by Auckland RC last season; 10 races in FY14, 7 races in FY13.

Turnover summary notes:

Total NZ thoroughbred turnover is down 1.5% year to date.

With 113 less races than run over the same period last season, turnover per race has actually increased, up 2.9%. Total starts made by thoroughbreds in NZ are down 1,101, 3.9% less.

Average field size is up from 10.41 in FY13 to 10.38 in FY14, 0.03 starters per race (0.3%) more.

The number of races with less than 8 starters is now 32 higher than a season ago.

The decline in NZ thoroughbred totalisator turnover (down 4.9%) has been partly offset by an increase in FOB turnover (up 11.5%).
