FROM THE HORSE'S MOUTH

Last Saturday was a special day for leading owner and breeder Kevin Hickman with Silent Achiever taking out the \$500,000AU Group 1 Ranvet Stakes at Rosehill Gardens and Emerald Queen's win in the \$70,000 Listed Valachi Downs South Island Thoroughbred Breeders Stakes at Riccarton on the same day.

Silent Achievers win was a great result for the New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeding Industry and franked the Group 1 form of the \$200,000 Lindauer New Zealand Stakes run at Ellerslie on 8 March.

This weekend all eyes will be on the Group 1 \$225,000 The Oaks Stud Manawatu Sires Produce Stakes for 2YO's over 1400m. The Stephen McKee trained O'Marilyn currently holds favouritism with NZRB bookmakers at \$4.20 ahead of Passing Shot \$7.50 and Platinum Balos at \$8.00.

TRACKSIDE CHANNEL EXCLUSIVELY ON SKY FROM 14 APRIL 2014

Premier events such as the Melbourne Cup, the New Zealand Trotting Cup, New Zealand Galloping Cup, Wellington Cup, Karaka Million, Waikato Sprint, Auckland Cup, Harness Jewels and the Great Northern Steeplechase will continue to be broadcast on Prime.

WOODVILLE PAHIATUA RC - MONDAY 31 MARCH 2014 - MEETING CANCELLED

The Woodville Pahiatua Racing Club race meeting programmed for Monday 31 March 2014 has been cancelled due to the surface being too firm to race on and the absence of an irrigation system at the venue.

The programming of a replacement licence at an alternative venue was considered by NZTR, the Regional Programming Committee and the NZ Trainers' Association. It was agreed to be unnecessary given the significant volume of alternative opportunities in the region in the next fortnight.

One additional race has been programmed for the Otaki Maori RC race meeting on Thursday 3 April: Maiden 3YO SW 1200m \$7,000 \$4,375, \$1,400, \$700, \$350, \$175

NZTR will consider dividing races in the region in the next fortnight based on nomination numbers.

THOROUGHBRED RACING CONNECTIONS FIGURE PROMINENTLY AT HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW

Thoroughbred racing connections figured prominently at last week's NRM Horse of the Year Show in Hastings.

These included Mark du Plessis's daughter, Isabelle, who won the Showing Pony of the Year Award; Aliesha Moroney won the Dressage Level Three Horse of the Year title class with Sinderella FE; and Natacha Otto took the Bates Saddles Supreme Park Hack of the Year title she won in 2013 aboard 12-year-old Cuvée, a former racehorse. Also in support of the Thoroughbreds in Equestrian Sport (TiES) initiative, the big Jumping class – the Norwood Gold Cup - was won by Luke Dee and his 13-year-old chesnut Thoroughbred Ombudsman and the Bayer Lady Rider of the Year crown was won by Lucy Akers on Thoroughbred Cortaflex Tinapai.

Gold medal-winning paralympian Jo Jackson won three times in Para Equestrian Dressage competitions on her ex-racehorse Nonchalant. The 16-year-old Thoroughbred mare suffered a life-threatening paddock injury in 2011. It was a long road back, but in 2013, Jackson and Nonchalant won the Grade Four Para-dressage Championship at Horse of the Year. Jackson has been riding Nonchalant for about four years. Longer term, Jackson has her eye on riding for New Zealand at the Rio Olympics.

At the NRM Horse of the Year Show Dinner Catriona Williams of Little Avondale Stud and founder of Catwalk, a charity involved in trying to find a cure for spinal cord injury, was inducted into the Hall of Fame by Sir Mark Todd. CatWalk patron Zara Phillips sent her congratulations, saying how impressed she always has been with Williams tenacity and total commitment. "She inspires people in so many ways," she wrote. Lance O'Sullivan, who is also involved with Catwalk, was interviewed by radio personality Jamie Mackay, entertaining the dinner guests with stories of people and horses over his career.

Meeting details

- Whakatane RC Monday equivalent meeting was a Thursday in early April 2013. Meeting ran 7 races this season, 8 in FY13.
- South Canterbury RC Thursday equivalent meeting was in mid-April last season. Meeting ran 7 races in FY14, 9 races in FY13.
- Waipukurau JC Friday meeting was abandoned after 3 races due to an inconsistent racing surface. 8 races were run last season.
- Waverley RC Sunday meeting ran 8 races this season, was abandoned in FY13.

Turnover summary notes:

- Total NZ thoroughbred turnover is down 1.1% year to date.
- With 65 less races than run over the same period last season, turnover per race has actually increased, up 2.3%.
- Total starts made by thoroughbreds in NZ are down 597, 2.9% less.
- Average field size is up from 10.33 in FY13 to 10.37 in FY14, 0.04 starters per race (0.4%) more.
- The number of races with less than 8 starters is now 25 higher than a season ago.
- Decline in NZ thoroughbred totalisator turnover (down 4.2%) has been partly offset by an increase in FOB turnover (up 10.7%).
- \$NZ export turnover per race to 23 February is down (12.9%). The variance in the \$NZ/\$A exchange rate is responsible for 11.7% of this decline. The remainder of this decline (1.2%), as well as the absence of any growth, appears to have resulted from the loss of coverage on Sky 1 in Australia for midweek races run after 2pm.
