



## NZTR DIRECTIVE

---

### Race Track Entry

Effective 3 June 2011

The Board of New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing has approved a resolution and, pursuant to Rule 106 (b), issued the following Directive, dated 3 June 2011:

No persons are permitted to enter the race track during the running of a race without the permission of a Stipendiary Steward.

The only persons permitted on a race track during the running of a race are authorised persons engaged in the running of the race meeting.

### Reason:

This directive has been issued in order to increase the safety and welfare of horses and riders.

### Rule of Rule Relating to Directives:

106(b)

Every person commits a breach of these Rules who:

acts in contravention of or fails to comply with any provision of these Rules or any Regulations made thereunder, or any notice, direction, instruction, requirement or condition given, made or imposed under these Rules;
