Trainers and Float operators are advised that it is a requirement of the Canterbury Jockey Club Horse Containment Policy that all floats unload and load within the confines of the contained Float Park. Horses are not to be unloaded or loaded anywhere other than within this area.

HORSE CONTAINMENT - GATES CLOSED: Trainers and Float operators are reminded that all gates to the stables on Racecourse and Yaldhurst Roads are always to remain closed. This is a major safety issue as closed gates prevent horses escaping off the property onto the surrounding roads

### LICENCE DISPLAY:
